

- Town Hall hours are Mon-Thurs 7AM-6PM. The Board of Trustees meets the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month.
- Municipal Court is held the first Thursday of every month at 2:30PM

- Residential trash is collected every Monday. Commercial trash is collected every Monday and Thursday, Make sure cans are out in the proper place by 7AM on collection days.
- Town Utility bills are due the 20th of every month. A \$10 late fee is assessed on the 21st of every month for all unpaid utility bills. Water shut off for unpaid bills is the 4th of every month.
